Keep sending in your *rear projection gone bad* pix.

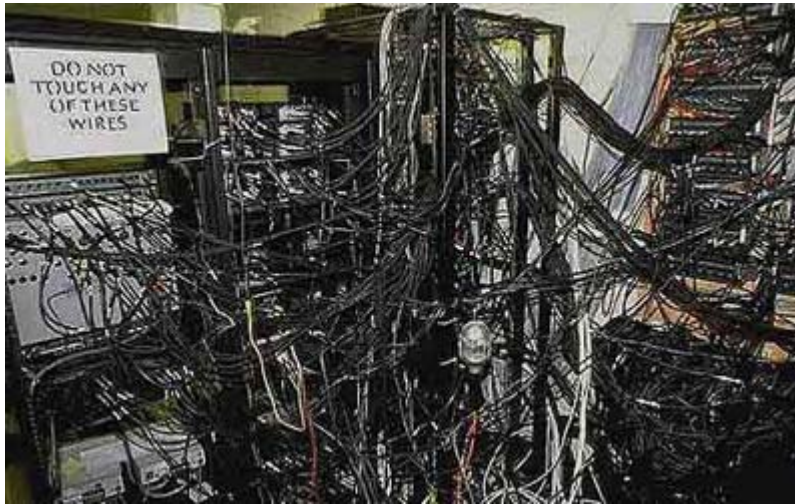
We are having a contest to determine the worst rear projection install.

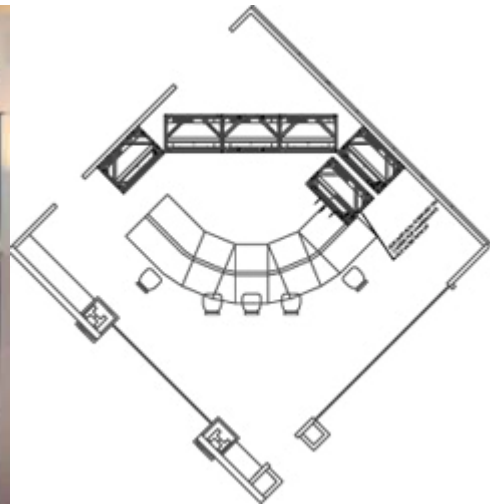
